**S**tylianos Zachopoulos, age 64, loving husband of Katherine (nee Hatzis) married for 39 years, dear father of Georgia and Apostolos “Paul,” brother of Vangeli (Ellie) and Dino, son of Apostolos and Antigoni (both deceased), brother-in-law of Harry Hatzis, passed away unexpectedly in Greece on July 13, 2016. Stylianos was born and raised in Greece and held great pride in his Greek heritage. He moved to the United States in 1981 at the age of 29 to make a better life for himself and his family. An accomplished engineering professional, he completed studies both abroad and locally in Cleveland earning his doctorate in civil engineering from Cleveland State University. Well-respected in Northeast Ohio professionally as an engineer, he held the title of principle engineer at MWH Global where he had been employed for near 30 years. 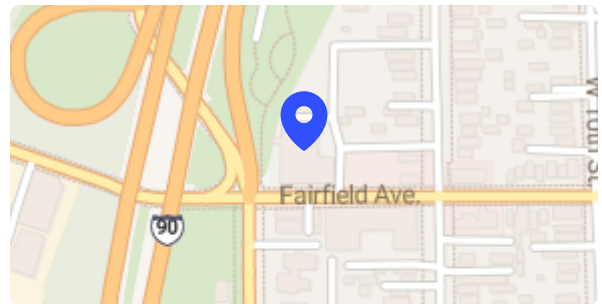

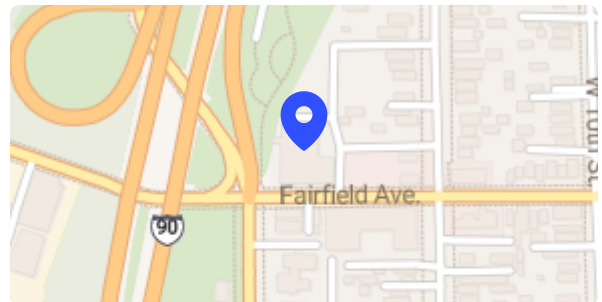

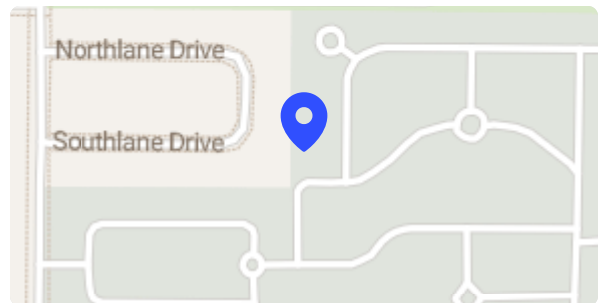
