Interment at St. Theodosius Cemetery.



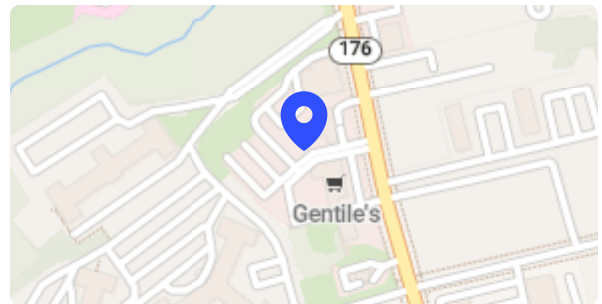
