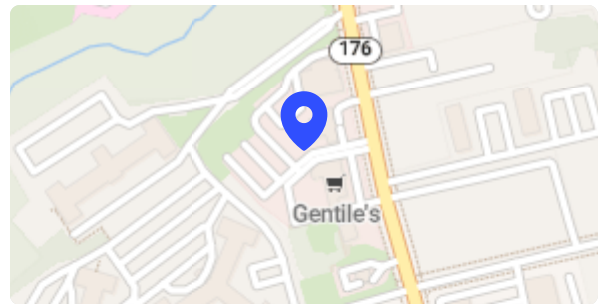
SEP 27, 1961 - NOV 21, 2019

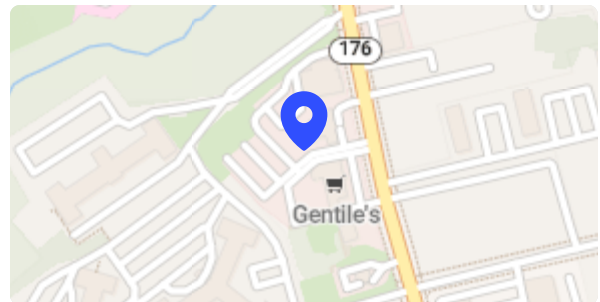

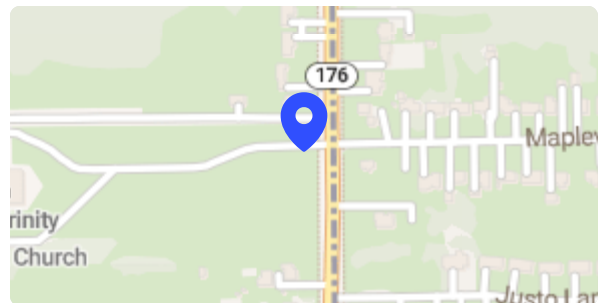

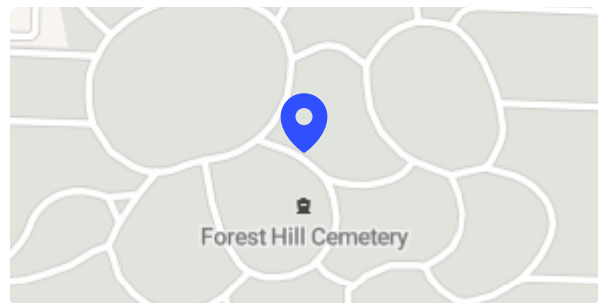

So sorry that we've lost Janet. Condolences to all who knew her, especially her mother Joanne, sister Chris, and her beloved dogs Bert and Mika. I first got to know Jan about 4 or so years ago when a regular group began to meet most mornings at the Lakewood dog park. I was part of this group with my then dog Mika, as was Jan with her dogs Bert and Toby. We laughed a lot, and enjoyed each other's company and dogs. At some point later Toby Beagle died after a long happy dog life, and our morning dog group began to break up for a variety of reasons. About 20 months ago my poor walking got much worse, and I spent a few weeks at a rehab facility for my walking. 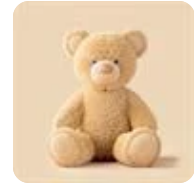
