She taught Jewelry Making, Metalsmithing and Precious Metal Clay at the Brecksville Center for the Arts. She was PMC Guild Certified to teach classes in Precious Metal Clay and taught classes at the Creative Block in Rocky River Ohio.

She was a member of the following organizations: The Ohio Arts & Crafts Guild, Society of North American Goldsmiths (SNAG), Ohio Arts Council - Ohio On-Line Visual Artist Registry, American Watchmakers-Clockmakers Institute (AW), The Brecksville Center for the Arts, The PMC Guild & the National Association of Independent Artists. She was a vendor at dozens of indoor and outdoor shows and later went on to open Eye Candy Gallery in Tremont, Ohio specializing in fine art, fine craft, and fine gifts.

Rita was an avid traveler and scuba diver visiting multiple countries. In her retirement, Rita enjoyed going to movies, traveling and spending time with friends and family and her two cats Willow and Alexander the Great.

In lieu of flowers, donations to the estate will be distributed amongst her list of beloved charities.



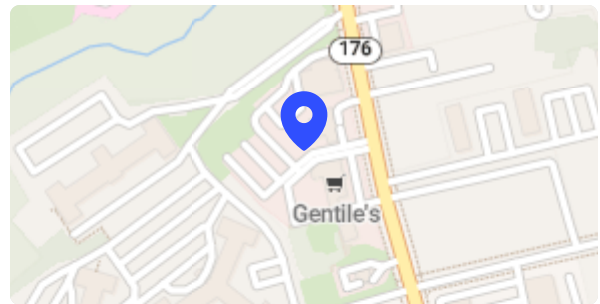
